

Leadership Parker County is a program sponsored by the **Parker County Chamber of Commerce** which challenges its participants to make a difference in the community, to make a positive contribution to our quality of life, and to be prepared to become the leaders of tomorrow. *Here are some facts about the program:*

Leadership Parker County is a challenge.

A series of nine full-day sessions (one day each month) offer learning opportunities and challenge participants to become actively involved in building a better tomorrow for Parker County. Sessions focus on the following important issues: Industry, City/County Government, Education, Health Care, Agriculture, Transportation, Technology, Communication, and Quality of Life.

Leadership Parker County is a commitment.

Leadership Parker County requires a commitment from completion of the application through graduation. This commitment involves one day per month for regular sessions that run September through May. A tuition of \$600 covers meals and other program expenses.

Leadership Parker County is an investment.

By creating a leadership pool for the present and the future, Leadership Parker County is truly an investment in our community. Leadership Parker County strives to ensure continuity of leadership for the community. Participation in the program is a commitment to take the contributions from former leaders and to build on that foundation. Through Leadership Parker County, potential leaders are identified.

The program creates an awareness of community resources and needs, while enhancing existing leadership skills.

Leadership Parker County is ongoing.

Upon completion of the program, Leadership Parker County participants are eligible for membership in the Leadership Alumni Association. Alumni members assist the organization in continuing the process of leadership development. The Alumni Association provides a continuing education forum for past participants, including programs dealing with issues of importance to Parker County.

Leadership Parker County is an opportunity.

The application deadline is AUGUST12TH. Participants will be notified of acceptance by August 26.

Leadership Parker County will begin with a mandatory orientation/mixer (Sept. 23, 3:00 - 5:00 PM) and ROPES course (Sept. 24) that will acquaint the participants with each other and the program. This first session is the essential step in creating bonds and friendships that will last a lifetime.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Application to Leadership Parker County is open to persons living and working in the Parker County area. A minimum of 12 and maximum of 16 individuals will be selected.
- Participants are chosen by the Leadership Parker County Selection Committee based upon the information on this application. The Committee seeks representation from a cross section of the community including business, agriculture, industry, education, the arts, religion, government, community-based organizations, retired residents, etc.
- Applicants must have the full support of the organization or corporation they represent.
- Due to class size limitations, depending on the number of applicants, the committee may limit selections to no more than one participant from a single company.
- Applicants who are not accepted due to class size limit are encouraged to reapply the following year.
- Attendance at orientation/mixer (Sept 23, 3:00-5:00 PM), Retreat/ROPES Course (September 24, 8:30 5:00) and monthly sessions are mandatory. (Sessions will be held the third Wednesday of each month September through May). Class dates are: September, October, November, December, January, February, March, April, May. Each session will run from 9:00 AM-5:00 PM. Those who fail to attend will forfeit their program participation and tuition.
- In reviewing applications, the Selection Committee looks for potential participants who demonstrate the following criteria:
 - **1.** Commitment and motivation to serve the Parker County area.
 - **2.** Policy shaping responsibility or position of leadership in employment and/or volunteer organizations resulting in the potential to have significant influence on important community issues.
 - **3.** Ability to fulfill the time commitment required by the program.
